

Credit Card on File Policy

At Vue Dermatology & Laser, we require patients with commercial insurance, Medicare without a secondary (supplemental) policy, and those that are self-pay to keep an active credit card on file. Medicare patients with a secondary policy are exempt. This policy helps improve efficiency and reduce administrative burdens, allowing us to focus on what truly matters—your medical care.

How It Works

- Your card details will be securely stored with Payment Card Industry (PCI)-validated point-to-point encryption using a third-party credit card processing platform.
- Staff will only have access to the cardholder's name and partial card number.
- After insurance has processed your claim, you will receive a statement for the balance.
- The credit card on file will only be charged if payment is not received within 30 days of the statement date.
- After receiving the statement, and prior to the card being charged, you may ask questions, dispute a charge, request a payment plan, or provide an alternate payment method.
- Credit cards on file will also be used for appointment cancellation and no-show fees.
